Opinion

We have audited the accompanying quarterly financial results of A INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED ("the Company") for the quarter and year ended 31st March, 2021 ("the Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us the Statement:

- are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulations 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii. give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the guarter and year ended 31st March, 2021.

Basis of Opinion

- The above financial results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and have been approved by Board of Directors at its meeting held on 30th June, 2021.
- 3 The Company has entered into an agreement on 25th June, 2018 as amended time to time for purchase of land and related assets of Distellary unit from M/s J.R. Organics Ltd. An advance of Rs. 23.27 Crore has been given by the company to M/s J.R. Organics Ltd. till 31st March, 2021 which has been included in Capital Work-in-Progress.
- 4 The Board has recommended dividend @ 2% i.e Rs. 0.10 per equity share for the financial year 2020-21 subject to approval of shareholder at the Annual General Meeting of the company.
- 5 The Board has recommended dividend @ 5% on redeemable Preference Shares for the financial year 2020-21
- The above results of the company have been audited by the statutory auditors and have issued an unqualified audit opinion on the same. The figures for the quarter ended 31.03.2020 and 31.03.2021 are the balancing figures between the audited figures of the full financial year and the unaudited year to date figure upto the third quarter of the respective financial years. Also, the figures upto the end of the third quarter were only reviewed and not subjected to audit.
- 7 The Company has only one operating segment i.e, A.C. Sheets and Pipes.
- In March 2020, the WHO declared the COVID-19 outbreak as a pandemic which continues to spread across the country and the globe. On 25th March 2020, the Government of India has declared this pandemic a health emergency and ordered the lockdown throughout the country. During the period of lockdown, operations of the Company has been substantially reduced. The Company after relaxation of the lockdown as per the guidelines issued by the Government commenced its operations. Management believes that it has taken into account all the possible impacts of known events arising from COVID-19 pandemic and the resultant lockdowns in the preparation of the financial results including but not limited to its assessment of Company's liquidity and as a going concern, recoverable values of its property, plant and equipment, trade receivables, inventory and other assets. The impact of the global health pandemic may be different from that estimated as at the date of approval of these financial results. Considering the continuing uncertainties the Company will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions and consequential impact on its financial results.
- 9 Exceptional Item represent loss on sale of shares.
- 10 Figures for the previous period have been regrouped / reclassified wherever necessary, to conform to current period's classification.
